- Referrals to local and telehealth providers and support groups
- Culturally sensitive support
- · Counselors who speak English and Spanish
- Interpreter services in 60 languages



HOTLINE COUNSELORS

- Licensed health care providers such as nurses or doctors
- · Licensed mental health clinicians
- · Certified doulas or childbirth educators
- · Certified peer support specialists

HOTLINE SERVICES

- Real-time emotional support, encouragement, information, and resources
- Referrals to local or telehealth providers
- Culturally appropriate and trauma-informed support
