While carrying the wooden cross, Tom Schaer (above left) led the group of pro-life marchers around the abortion building seven times. With every round we stopped to read Scripture in unison. It was very powerful to hear the Word of God declared with a group of seventy or more sounding it out! There were about thirty people from the building for women who came to protest our prayer march. They stood on the sidewalk outside the building holding signs and playing their very foul music extremely loudly. "There is one body and one Spirit, just as there is one hope to which God has called you. There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism: there is one God and Father of all, who is Lord of all, works through all, and is in all. Each one of us has received a special gift in proportion to what Christ has given. As the scripture says: "When he went up to the very heights, he took many captives with him; he gave gifts to people." (Ephesians 4:4-8) As ONE BODY many members of the Church of Jesus Christ gathered together in one place (The Building NOT for Women) for the Annual Jericho March in Duluth, Minn. Christians from churches in Wisconsin as well as Minnesota, joined forces to do battle with the enemy, our foe, the prince of darkness, Satan himself. The battle was engaged with Satan's cohorts; the escorts that Planned Parenthood uses to shuttle women from their cars into the building where their babies are killed on a weekly basis. Israel and Abortion by Sarah Winandy

The chant "from the river to the sea, Palestine will be free" means let Palestine live and let Israel and the Jewish people die. They want to live and get rid of the Jews. Annihilate a people—why? Because of hate? Because they are in the way? Of course it goes deeper than that because it's a spiritual matter. God called Abraham to a land:

For all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed for ever. (Gen. 13:15)

Further, he is instructed:

Arise, walk through the land in the length of it and in the breadth of it: for unto thee will I give it. (Gen. 13:17)

See these verses as referring to the literal land:

By faith Abraham, when he was called, obeyed to go out unto a place which he was to receive for an inheritance; and he went out, not knowing whither he went. By faith he became a sojourner in the land of promise, as in a land not his own, dwelling in tents,

with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise. (Heb. 11:8,9)

Through judgements on Israel from God, Bible history reveals that many times the Jews were dispersed from the land but returned. Then Jesus prophesied:

For the days will come upon you when your enemies will throw up a barricade against you, and surround you and hem you in on every side, and they will level you to the ground and your children within you, and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not recognize the time of your visitation. (Luke 19:43-44 NASB)

This was fulfilled when the Jewish people were dispersed in 70 A.D. through Roman aggression. However, the dramatic fact of Israel's return to the land in *our day* after many centuries of dispersion, persecution, and affliction reveal another prophecy fulfilled:

Who has ever heard of such things? Who has ever seen things like this? Can a country be born in a day or a nation be brought forth in a moment? Yet no sooner is Zion in labor than she gives birth to her children. (Isaiah 66:8)

And I will bring again the captivity of my people of Israel, and they shall build the waste cities, and inhabit them; and they shall plant vineyards, and drink the wine thereof; they shall also make gardens, and eat the fruit of them. And I will plant them upon their land, and they shall no more be pulled up out of their land which I have given them, saith the Lord thy God. (Amos 9:14–15)

Wanting to annihilate Israel is not a new thing in history; a study would reveal many instances in the Bible where the enemies of God wanted to destroy them.

Show Your lovingkindness to Your people Israel and keep them as the apple of Your eye. Hide them under

I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your impurities and from all your idols. I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my Spirit in you and move you to follow my decrees and

be careful to keep my laws. Then you will live in the land I gave your ancestors; you will be my people, and I will be your God. (Ez. 36:22-29)

Unborn children have something in common with Israel, especially these days. Both are hated by Satan. Both are marked for destruction and annihilation. Both are hated and despised—why? They are in the way? They are an inconvenience? But it goes much deeper than that. It is a spiritual reason. Consider the sacredness of human life, the devil hates it. Yet the book of Wisdom says: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him and He shall direct your path. Do not be wise in your own eyes, fear the Lord and depart from evil.

It shall be health to your navel and marrow to your bones." (Prov. 2:3-4)

There is a saying that says "If you want to make God laugh, tell Him your plans!" Behind the comical aspect of that saying is a deep truth.

Isaiah 55:6-9 gives us a glimpse of the mind of God toward us: "Seek the Lord while he may be found; call upon him while he is near; let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; let him return to the Lord, that he may have compassion on him, and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.
